
## **EAPF** Digital e-newsletter

Earlier this year we sent our first ever digital e-newsletter on 28 April 2017 to contributing members by email. We also re-sent our e-newsletter on 15 May 2017 (only to those who <u>hadn't</u> opened our e-newsletter in April).

We surveyed our members on 30 May 2017 by email asking what they thought about our new digital format and content this year.

Our survey was only sent out to those who'd opened our newsletter email in April and May.


A total of 248 people completed our survey.




#### How did you feel about our digital newsletter?

We asked what you thought of our digital newsletter on a scale of 1 to 5 (with 1 being completely dissatisfied and 5 being completely satisfied).

- 64% of members rated between 4 and 5 on how happy they were with the digital format
- 73% of members rated between 3 and 4 on how relevant articles were to them.






How relevant were the

#### How did you feel about our digital newsletter?


We asked what you thought of our digital newsletter on a scale of 1 to 5 (with 1 being completely dissatisfied and 5 being completely satisfied).
